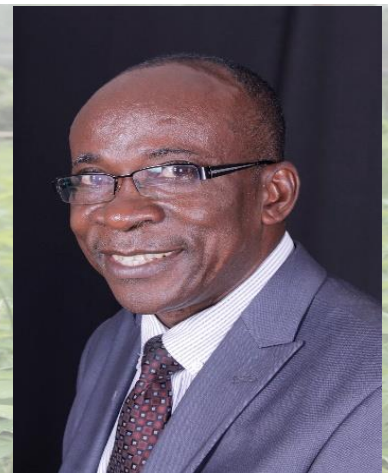

Bamboo is a food source for humans, and feed and fodder for livestock. Bamboo shoots are an important traded commodity, a nutrition rich food and are associated with cuisine and culture across Asia, Africa and Latin America. Agro-pastoral economies need quality feed and fodder to mitigate global shortages.

This session will showcase the bamboo shoot industry value-chain, its products and its benefits to smallholder farmers in China; a smallholder bamboo juice/wine collection system, and its benefits in Tanzania; and empirical evidence on the suitability of bamboo as green feed and fodder for livestock in Ghana.
